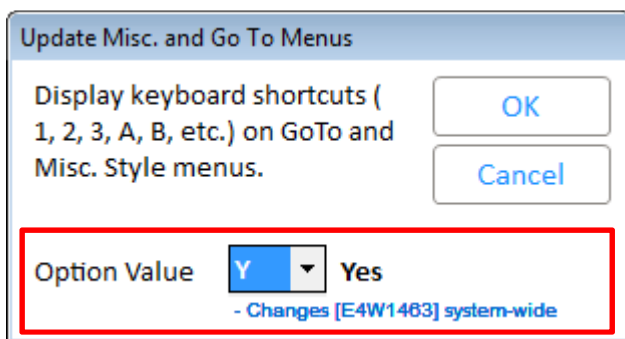
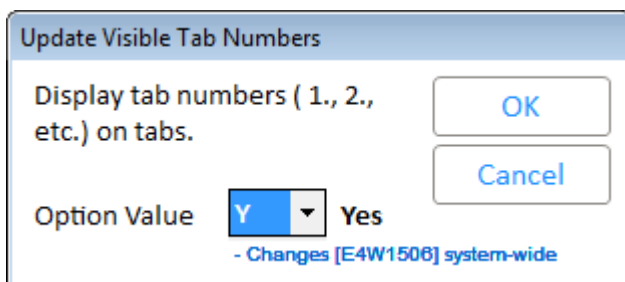


## These Options can be updated with the Eagle N Series Compatibility Utility.

Option ID 1463 determines if keyboard shortcuts are displayed on the GoTo and Misc. style menus. You can see this option number referenced in the 'Update Misc. and Go To Menus' dialog box. Note the text "Changes [E4W 1463] system-wide" under the Option Value drop down box.




When option 1506 is set to Yes, the tab numbers are displayed to remind the user of the shortcut key. You can control this setting via the Visible Tab Numbers section in the Compatibility Utility.



Options 1507, 1508 and 1509 control the ability to use various compass-based Eagle N Series features in Inventory Maintenance, Customer Maintenance and Vendor Maintenance respectively. These are also found in the Compass Features section of the utility.

Options 1510 thru 1518 allow you to determine if the application uses the toolbar with Eagle F-keys or if it uses the Ribbon Bar with its new features. The Eagle for Windows Toolbars section allows you to set these options to Yes or No by module.
