

Review the following Options and Security settings prior to using the Inventory Maintenance Change Log.

Option ID #808 must be set to 'Yes' so that changes to the SKU records are tracked. Notice that this option is password protected. Contact the Eagle Advice Line to update this flag if needed.

Once the Eagle system begins tracking changes, you will want to assign security bit 714 to those employees who will be using the Inventory Maintenance Change Viewer.

Changes made to Inventory Maintenance through Network Access on a Legacy system are not logged. It's a good idea to change security bits 658 and 682 to 'No' for all roles. This prevents access to the legacy application to avoid changes being made which will not be tracked.
