Eagle Mobile Inventory Information Tabs

Eagle Mobile+ gives you the ability to see some very pertinent Inventory information without having to go to a computer or connect to Wi-Fi.

This Training on Demand course will introduce you to the data available within the Inventory menu including the Stocking, Pricing, History, Codes, Vendor, Purchase Order, and Committed Quantity tabs.

Let's launch the app, and take a look at inventory maintenance in Eagle Mobile+.

One of the best things about Eagle Mobile+ is the ability to multi-task.

When you launch the application you will Login and then confirm the 'User' and selected 'Store'.

Click the left Navigation Menu with the 3 horizontal lines to expand the available functions.

Selecting 'Inventory' then 'Inventory Maint.' will allow you to scan or enter a UPC code or a SKU.

To the right of the Item field is a 'Magnifying Glass' icon which enables a search function.

Here, we can enter an item's SKU or UPC.

You can also click the 'Scan' button at the bottom of the screen to enable the camera on your device.

Carefully position the item in front of the camera so that the red line is over the barcode.

We will enter an item number here and press 'Go'.

The top of the screen displays the Item SKU, the description, a hyperlink to the item's UPC, and, for multi-store users, a store hyperlink to view information on other stores.

Tapping the UPC link allows you to manually add a new UPC code. You can also utilize the camera function on your device and scan in a new UPC code.

Click the back arrow in the lower left corner to return to the main screen.

The stocking tab contains basic information from Eagle Browser's Inventory Maintenance screen.

You can view the 'Manufacturers Part Number', the 'Quantity On-hand', 'Quantity On Order' and 'Future Purchase Orders'.

The 'Retail', 'Standard Pack', 'Order Multiple', 'Order Point', are displayed along with the 'Stocking' and 'Purchasing Units of Measure'.

History values include 'YTD' sales, 'LY' sales and the last 12 period's.

To navigate to the other tabs within Inventory Maintenance, you can tap on the tabs, [long pause] or use the left and right arrows. The Pricing tab follows Eagle Browser security rules.

If you are allowed to view cost and GP% information in Eagle, it will display on your Eagle Mobile+ device.

If you're looking for something particular and can't find it, check with your manager to see if your security access needs to be updated.

Assuming you have the proper security, the pricing tab displays the Retail Price, the List Price and the Promo Price.

You can also view the Average, Replacement, and Manufacturing Cost.

The Desired Gross Profit percentage and actual GP are listed at the bottom.

This pricing screen obviously contains information that you may not want a shopper to see. Use the Eagle Mobile+ 'Price Check' screen when sharing data with customers. This is accessed from the left navigation menu.

The history tab contains some key dated pieces of information such as the 'Last Sale Date', 'Last Receipt Date', 'Receipt Quantity', as well as the 'Last Physical Inventory Date'.

The item's 'To Date' sales and 'Quantity On-hand' values display.

Down below, you will see sales history buckets for the current and last 12 periods.

'Year-To-Date', 'Last Year' and 'Last 12' periods sales units is also available. The Codes tab displays all 20 inventory codes that you would find in Eagle IMU.

View the 4 User Code fields as well as the 4 Expanded User Codes.

Eagle Mobile+ gives you the ability to actually change code values from this tab.

Just tap the code field, enter the new value, press 'Done', and then tap the 'Save' icon.

Other code fields that are displayed, but unchangeable, include the 'Discontinued' flag, Store 'Closeout' flag, the 'Popularity' code, 'Order Indicator' field, 'Seasonal' Sales Code and 'Promotional' code.

The Vendor tab allows you to review the Primary and Manufacturing Vendors assigned in Eagle Inventory Maintenance.

The code and description for the item's 'Department', 'Class' and 'Fineline' are also visible.

If this item is on an open purchase order, selecting the PO tab displays purchase order information.

Here we see the 'PO' number, the 'Status', the 'Vendor' code, 'Due Date' and 'Quantity On Order'.

If there are multiple open purchase orders, they are viewable one at a time.

There are 'Previous' and 'Next' buttons if there are more open PO's than can fit on a single screen.

If this item is included on any open customer sales orders, the Committed Quantity tab will contain some valuable information.

You can see the 'Customer' number, the customer 'Short ID', and the quantities committed for this item.

As you can see, Eagle Mobile+ gives you access to the main fields of Inventory Maintenance for either display purposes or to actually modify fields.

This tool offers a mobile way to access inventory information while walking the floor, so updates can be performed much more quickly and easily.
