search for "Shockwave Flash Object" (another name for Flash Player).

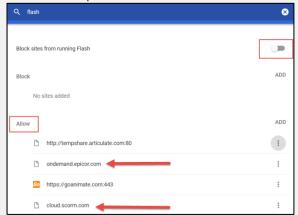
In the Status column, check

to see if the Shockwave Flash Object option is disabled. If so, click on the corresponding row to highlight the object.

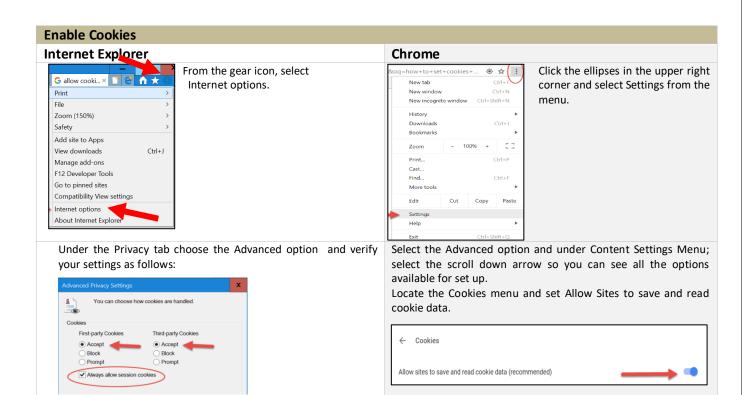
Click the Enable button in the lower right corner.

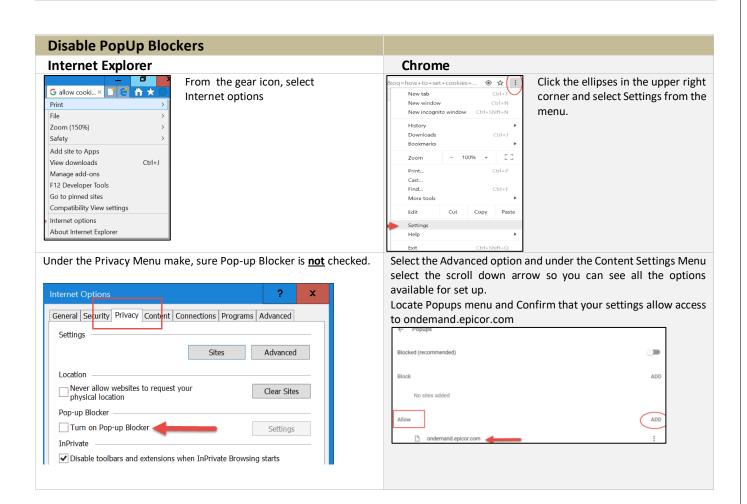

Click the Tools icon in the upper right corner (the icon is shaped like a gear) From the Security tab, click the Trusted Sites icon and then click the Sites button.



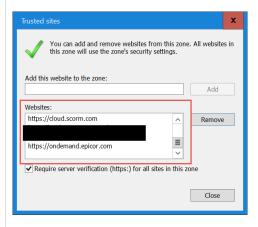
Chrome

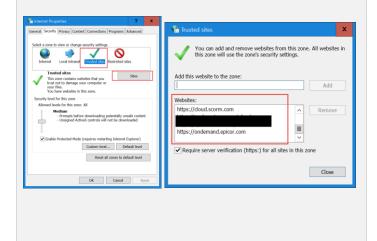
Add the following by entering the full addresses and clicking the Add button. Click Close and then OK to save.

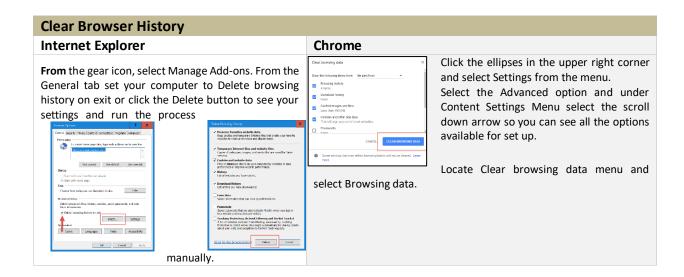


On the Security Tab select Trusted Sites and click the Sites button. Enter the full address and click the Add button; click Close and then OK to save.

Check for Virus Software Conflicts

PC utilization can peak due to other programs running either within the browser or on PC itself. For example if a Virus Software starts to run on the PC while user is engaged in a course will slow the PC and decrease its utilization.

We have one more thing you can check. After you have already reviewed that you are allowing Flash Player and you are not blocking cookies and the sites are listed as a trusted sites in your browser security settings and you continue to have issues. The problem may be that your Firewall is configured to block the video content from loading. We recommend working with your local IT team and review your firewall settings.
