

What's New Eagle Release 28

Are you looking for easier ways to utilize serial numbers in your business? Were there some features you were hoping to see in Point of Sale? Well, you're in luck! Epicor Eagle Release 28 contains some cool new features that will help you - grow your business!

Take a few minutes to explore the Range Management enhancements, new POS features, the changes to Serial Number and Inventory maintenance, along with some A/P updates and few miscellaneous items. Range Management

With the addition of Smartwaiver integration, Eagle Point of Sale can query Range Management for a waiver for each member of a party and display the matching records. The waiver can be viewed or printed. Use new Option IDs 1812 and 1813 with this feature.

We have added a new Viewer to manage and help reconcile the Eagle Firearms serial number inventory with the FFLCM Bound Books for each store. Use Option ID 1849 and Security Bit 1159.

Point of Sale Enhancements

You may now ask customers to donate to a charity right on your PIN pad. If they decline, they will be prompted to press "No Thanks" instead of "Cancel". You also have the option to require a signature with EMV or chip cards.

Option ID 1822 defaults can be set to Yes or No. This does not affect PIN based transactions or cards that require a PIN. You can also add a customer's address

and other information by swiping or scanning their driver's license. Set Option ID 1824 to P or S to scan the license barcode or use your PIN pad.

Serial Number Enhancements

You can now add the Manufactured Part Number and UPC column to the Serial Number Viewer. You can also add new serial numbers to a SKU in the Serial Number Viewer. Use the Miscellaneous Button to select Maintain Serial Numbers. Use the Add button to update your data. And to make using serial number even easier, there is new Option ID 1848 and 1846! These allow you to scan or import serial numbers during the Receiving process. Review the online Help for details on both processes.

Inventory Enhancements

The Item List Maintenance Viewer now contains Date of the last physical inventory. And the Modify Item Promotion Viewer has a Date Last Sale column to show you when the item was last sold.

Accounts Payable Enhancements

New Option 1823 has been added to allow Freight Charges in MRV. When set to Yes, in the AP Assist Viewer or APA, select the Invoice that you would like to include when updating the freight charge in MVR. Then click on option 6 to Include Invoice Freight when Posting.

Miscellaneous Enhancements

In Epicor Eagle Release 28 you can run the Calculate Loyalty Points report by typing CALCPNT in the launch bar. If you are a Loyalty customer, refer to additional online help referencing Converting Sales to Loyalty Points. And finally, there is a new background displayed in the Views Manager Update dialog for Offline Point of Sale. This will help distinguish the Views Manager from online.
